## Scope

The existing HPD eBW web service allows HPD to query the eBW data and obtain warrant information on potential matches. HPD must access the service via authenticated, encrypted means (via HTTPS). NIC HI does not guarantee the results are exact matches. The results will be returned via JSON and are based on the criteria sent to NIC HI via the query. HPD can query based on First Name, Last Name, Birthdate, SSN, License No., or Criminal State ID No.

NIC HI will enhance the existing eBW web service to add Warrant Status, Bail Amount, and Ordered Date as query parameters so HPD can perform more targeted searches.
