Additional Benefits – The public can now view videos as well as more photos than in the past, so they can make more informed decisions regarding their bids.

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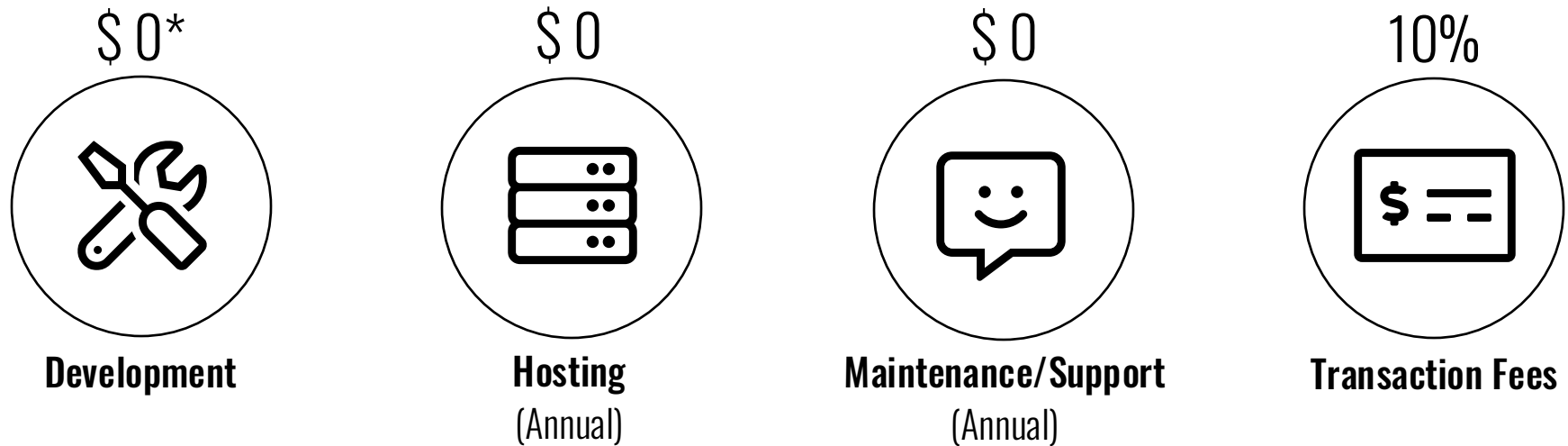
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Fees & Cost Structure

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Transaction Fees Breakdown

- Transaction fee (existing):
 - 10% of winning amount up to winning amount less than \$10,000 (credit card fee included)
 - \$1,000 for winning amount equal or greater than \$10,000 + 2.5% credit card fee
- Credit/debit card fee (updated):
 - Change from 3.0% to 2.5%
