Problem - Hawaii Department of Transportation - Airports (DOTA) only accepts cash, check, ACH and wire transfer payments. DOTA wants to accept credit card payments both online and at specific DOTA office locations.

Solution – Implement payments online and over the counter so public users can pay for their DOTA fees via credit card or eCheck; receive email confirmation; and allow DOTA staff to view online submissions, export the submitted form data via csv file, and view online fiscal reports.

Additional Benefits – Streamlined process for public users and DOTA; faster flow of funds into the DOTA bank account.


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
