Project Overview

New legislation requires enhancements to the existing Medical Cannabis Registration System.

SB1429 (increase in maximum number of qualifying patients per caregiver)

Caregivers will once again be allowed to cultivate for a patient. Additionally, a caregiver will be permitted to care for up to five (5) patients at a time.
