 - a. Department of Accounting and General Services State Procurement Office – Hawaii Compliance Express – SOW Amendment 2

<u>Hawaii Compliance Express</u> is an electronic system that provides vendors, contractors and service providers doing business with state or county agencies to quickly and easily document that they are compliant with applicable laws. This single certificate eliminates the need to obtain individual copies of clearances with Internal Revenue Service (IRS), Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (DLIR), Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (DCCA) and Department of Taxation (DoTAX).

This Statement of Work covers a mandated IRS process change. The IRS Admin online compliance verification will be replaced with a process that allows the user to upload an IRS Compliance document to the system.

2. Signed SOW

 a. Department of Health – Office of Medical Cannabis Control and Regulation – Medical Cannabis Registration System – SOW Amendment 7

The medical cannabis registry enables both patients and caregivers to apply and register in the program, enables Department of Health to manage registrants, and enables law enforcement to verify registrant information.

The purpose of this SOW amendment is to amend the scope relating to a bill that recently passed legislation – House Bill 302 (expansion of qualifying conditions). Under the new law, a patient's "treating medical provider" (such as their primary care doctor) or a hospice medical provider (if the patient is under hospice care) will now be able to certify a patient for conditions that are not currently listed as approved qualifying conditions. All other medical providers will still be limited to certifying a patient for one of the existing qualifying conditions.

<u>HANDS</u> gathers information from multiple state and county procurement platforms and displays it all in one place. Launched in 2017, it allows public users and vendors to search for business opportunities with the state or counties, browse notice solicitations and awards and register for the State's small business registration. Procurement staff can submit procurement requests, post new solicitations and manage award notices through posting, amendments, and cancellations.
