Project Overview

Problem: The HCJDC would like to upgrade all aspects of the current Online Sex Offender Public Registry Search web application.

Solution: The improvements will be implemented via four phases: upgraded site infrastructure and design, followed by a new custom mapping tool, then alternative search options and search results displays, and ending with updates to alerts, print displays, and addition of an announcements module.

Additional Benefits: The public will benefit from relying on a modernized web application, and the phased approach allows the HCJDC to determine order and timing of all phases after the initial phase.
