

(i) Background

- Go Hunt Hawaii, originally the Hunt Application System allows individuals to submit an electronic application to be entered into a lottery for the annual hunting seasons on the islands of Lanai, Hawaii, and Kauai
- Hunt Lottery automates the lottery drawing process for selecting hunters that have applied for annual game hunting opportunities on the island of Lanai
- Additional functionality includes registering and enrolling into Hunt classes and events, the ability to share announcements and events, as well as purchasing and replacing certification cards





Challenges & Objectives

- Prior to the original launch in 2014, the public individual applies online, in person, or by mail that will be used to be entered into the lottery drawing
 - o All applications received are assigned a draw number and group size
 - Division of Forestry and Wildlife team member manually enters the information of all received applications into an antiquated, MS-DOS system that does not have any backups if the system fails

Lottery Drawing Preparation

- All applications cards are printed including a master public list of all applications and their draw numbers
- o Listing is posted on the walls at the physical drawing location
- Coins containing the draw numbers are manually drawn from a bucket by a DOFAW team member and spectators

Lottery Drawing Completion


- o All draws are sealed and reviewed by a DOFAW to confirm there are no mistakes
- Results are posted on the http://dlnr.hawaii.gov/dofaw website a couple weeks out after drawing for the public
- Permits and tags are mailed to each application drawn with hunters required to bring these items at the check-in station the day of the hunt

- Go Hunt Hawaii now replaces the manual lottery drawing process and names for the lottery are automatically integrated and retrieved from the existing Hawaii Hunt Application System database
- Electronic applications can be entered into a lottery for mammal hunting
- Available Hunts can be viewed, selected and paid for at

- Additional functionality includes access to available Hunter Education classes, purchasing tags & permits, as well as viewing news, announcements, and FAQs regarding the Hunter Education program
- Admin functionality uses myHawaii Single-Sign On to login, citizen functionality requires cert number or user ID, DOB, and Last Name






Public View - Apply for a Hunt






Admin Login




