Remediation Plan

Application Review

- Based on application type, complexity, and application's release date to better understand impact on meeting standards
- Categorizing applications for quicker estimations
- Using an accessibility checklist to align with latest guidelines

Accessibility Assessment

- Evaluated using automated and manual testing tools to broaden conformance
- o Identifying and determining issues that can be fixed in its current environment
- o Recommendations on fixes, application retirement, or upgrade

Implementation Effort

- Prioritizing based on high severity and easily fixable
- Total development costs include Design, Development, QA, and PM time

Includes site assessment and evaluation


Projected Development Effort

Includes resourcing for accessibility fixes






Accessibility Issue Overview

WCAG Principles* – Perceivable, Operable, Understandable, Robust









Perceivable	Operable	Understandable	Robust
Information and user interface components must be presentable to users in ways they can perceive	User interface components and navigation must be operable	Information and the operation of the user interface must be understandable	Content must be robust enough that it can be interpreted by a wide variety of user agents, including assistive technologies
Examples: Color contrasts, font weights, size of tap areas, etc.	Examples: "Skip to main" link, tab order of interactives, etc.	Examples: language declared, readable, labels / instructions, etc.	Examples: Name, Role status messages, etc.
